**DR. JAY GORDON TO MARCH IN WASHINGTON
WITH JENNY MCCARTHY AND JIM CARREY TO “GREEN OUR VACCINES”**

[WASHINGTON, D.C, June 4, 2008]—Dr. Jay Gordon, nationally recognized pediatrician and an outspoken advocate for the reexamination of the safety and efficacy of childhood vaccinations, will walk alongside Jenny McCarthy and Jim Carrey to the Capitol Building in Washington D.C. on June 4 to urge Congress to “Green Our Vaccines.” The event, which is estimated to draw more than 10,000 participants, is sponsored by Talk About Curing Autism (TACA).

The main message will be this: eliminate all toxins from our children's vaccines and have our national health agencies reassess the mandatory vaccine schedule that our children are currently receiving – **TOO MANY, TOO SOON**. While Jenny, Jim and Dr. Gordon are not anti-vaccine, they do not support the current childhood vaccine schedule, and like many parents, they believe some agents in current vaccines are unsafe.

The group is demanding that Congress take action to **Green Our Vaccine** supply by reassessing our current vaccine schedule, enacting legislation that would eliminate all toxins from our children's vaccines, studying the relationship of neurological disorders in vaccinated versus unvaccinated children, and extending the statute of limitations to allow all children affected by vaccine induced injury to file in the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program (NVICP).



Jay Gordon M.D. FAAP, IBCLC, (emeritus) is a pediatrician in practice for 30 years. As a physician and family advocate he has lead the debate on vaccinations and the links to autism and other neurological disorders, and has produced an informative DVD, [“VACCINATIONS?
